



Remember!

Somalis are unique in the SLH Section -

- 1. For their medium size**
- 2. For their “Ticked” coat pattern**
- 3. For their “different” colour descriptions and combinations**

Remember that the Somali Standard of Points uses different terminology like “Usual”; “Sorrel” etc. and Somalis have different colours such as “cinnamon” & “fawn” that are not found in any other cats in the Semi-Longhair Section.

Remember that Chocolate Somalis should show a dark, “plain” chocolate different from that desired by other breeds.

Remember that when a coat is “ticked” the combination of colours on each hair makes even familiar colours look different from their appearance on other breeds. Dominant colours should be striking and vibrant. Dilute colours should be subtle, warm and soft.

FINALLY, REMEMBER WITH SOMALIS THE BREED NUMBERING IS DIFFERENT FROM OTHER BREEDS IN THE SEMI-LONGHAIR SECTION – eg 63A IS SORREL, 63C IS BLUE!
